

Distance Learning Seminar

Promotion of distance learning services at libraries was the focus of discussion during a symposium held on September 19 at the NCL. A total of 187 representatives from 62 organizations participated in the event, which was jointly organized by the NCL, Special Library Committee of the Library Association of China, and Taipei Chapter of the American Society for Information Science.

The symposium was chaired by NCL deputy director Sung Chien-cheng (宋建成). Prof. Li Kun-han (李昆翰) of Taipei Municipal Teachers College delivered the keynote speech on “Digital Learning: Strategies for Transmitting Knowledge in the Digital Age.” Other papers on the “Application of Digital Library Information in Open Distance Learning and Teaching” and “Establishment and Promotion of Distance Learning Resources at the NCL” were delivered, respectively, by National Taiwan University professor Yueh Hsiu-ping (岳修平) and Chen Chao-chen (陳昭珍) of the NCL Reader Services Dept.
