medical theory. Tchen Yu-chiou, chairwoman of the Council for Cultural Affairs and a former concert pianist, recommended Peter Mayle's *A Year in Provence*, in which the author describes the idyllic life in the alpine regions of southern France. Liao Hsien-hao, director of the Taipei City Bureau of Cultural Affairs, suggested Herman Hesse' famed *Demian* and encouraged people to "find strength within".

Business leaders also generously offered their recommendations for books on management theories in the fight against SARS. Landis Hotel president Stanley Yen urged readers to commit to memory The *Youngest Science* by Lewis Thomas. Patrick Poon, head of Greater China Region of ING Life Insurance, recommended Joan Magretta's popular management book, *What Management Is*. Legislator Luo Wen-chia suggested Yang Chin-tai's First Encounter: Taiwan in the 17th Century; Father John Baptist Wu offered Li Chia-tung's *The Bell Rings Again*; and Merit Times Daily News publisher Master Yung Yun recommended a collection of editorials from the Merit Times.

During the SARS outbreak, publishers were quick to position their books in the categories of spiritual support, leisure, health and fitness, home life, non-fiction, light reading, and faith in hopes of fostering reading as a stimulating force in society. Such efforts were aimed moreover at expanding interest in meaningful cultural products and thereby minimizing the impact of SARS on the publishing industry.
