- (2) Post-1949 publications
 - 1. Chinese publications about Taiwan: Over 200 volumes
 - Publications on frontier and ethnic topics: Over 700 volumes, many dating back to the 1960s and 70s
 - 3. Historical works: Over 470 volumes, mostly from the 1960s and 70s
 - 4. Commemorative books: 57 volumes
 - Biographies: Diaries, memoirs, chronicles, and discourse: 193 volumes, mostly from the 1960s and 70s, and secondly from the 1950s and 1980s.
- (3) Chinese periodicals: Periodicals printed in mainland China during the Republican era (49 types, including four types with first editions) and government publications printed in Taiwan since 1949 (61 types and over 1,500 issues)
- (4) Japanese periodicals: Over 90 volumes, including more than 40 volumes on the southern islands, over 30 volumes on China, and nine volumes on Taiwan, with the oldest volume dating back to 1912.

The donation strengthens the NCL's collection of publications from the early Republican period, works on Taiwan studies and the southern islands, and publications from the post WWII period through the 1970s. (Chinese text by Chen Te-han)
